The range of people who benefit from ATH services is broad. From youth through adolescence and adulthood, art therapy provides opportunities to increase creative coping skills, access and treat traumatic experience, normalize the lived experience, reframe history and build legacy, and encourage resilience and hope.

Clients are seen at our brick and mortar location in Brown Deer, WI as well as in the community and so some driving is required at times. This position will serve clients in mostly group settings with opportunities to provide individual services.

Job Title: Art Therapist

Requirements: Master's degree in art therapy, counseling, or a related field. State licensure to practice counseling, therapy, or art therapy in accordance with the Department Safety of Professional Services. A registered art therapist (ATR, ATR-BC) or psychotherapist (ATRL, LPC) is preferred, but training licenses such as the LPC-IT or ATR-P would be considered with additional supervision.

Candidates for this position must have a reliable vehicle, vehicle insurance, and a valid driver's license. As this position requires providing therapeutic services to vulnerable populations, candidates must be able to pass a caregiver background check.

General Job Descriptions: Art Therapists at Art Therapy House Inc. are responsible for providing art therapy services to clients, utilizing the creative process of art-making to help individuals and groups of all ages improve their mental and emotional well-being. Art therapists prepare and facilitate art therapy services and other wellness related programming in our home location (Brown Deer, WI) and within the community through partnerships. Art Therapy House Inc. programming includes individual art therapy, focused and themed groups, ongoing support groups, workshops, and open studio events.

Major Duties and Responsibilities:

- Conduct art therapy assessments to identify the client's needs and develop treatment plans that integrate art therapy techniques into clientele wellness goals.
- Provide and facilitate regular individual and group art therapy sessions that are designed to enhance the client's self-awareness, self-esteem, coping skills, and emotional regulation.
- Work with the therapeutic team including art therapy assistants to select and provide a range of art materials and techniques that are tailored to the client's age, developmental level, cultural background, and treatment goals.
- Clean up art materials and ensure that the art-making space is organized and clean after each session. Additional housekeeping duties may be assigned as needed.
- Monitor the inventory of art therapy materials and supplies at Art Therapy House Inc. and at community sites and report to the Operations Manager and art therapy assistants to coordinate orders for additional materials as needed.
- Travel to and from Art Therapy House Inc. and community partnership sites with art materials for programming, client artwork, and other necessary items for providing successful services.
- Meet with clients, management staff, community partners, and other stakeholders to monitor the effectiveness of programming, client progress towards treatment goals, and evaluate participant needs.
- Maintain accurate and timely records of client progress, treatment plans, and case notes in compliance with ethical and legal guidelines.
- Collaborate with other members of the Art Therapy House Inc. team, including other art therapists, the operations manager, executive director, art therapy assistants, interns, and community partners, to provide comprehensive and coordinated care to clients.
- Provide ongoing psychoeducation to clients, family members, and community organizations on the benefits of art therapy and its role in mental health treatment.

- Participate in clinical supervision and professional development activities to maintain licensure and stay current with developments in the field of art therapy.
